The Board is requested to approve Budget Ordinance Amendment No. 26BCC013 Public Health to Recognize \$13,826 from the NC DHHS Division of Public Health Epidemiology Section Communicable Disease Section Branch for Health Screenings

Background/Justification

As the number of refugee arrivals to Durham County has exceeded expectations, the Local Health Department will increase the number of screenings, for a new total of 800 screenings provided for State Fiscal Year 2025-2026. Funds will be used to increase staffing and provide the essential information and communications technology items for that additional staff, such as a computer and a phone, and provide needed refugee health training. This staff will increase the LHD's capacity to provide timely medical screening services to newly arriving refugees.
