Key Attributes

- **Consolidation** of classroom and range training



- No longer need to lease and travel to an offsite facility for classroom training
- All Basic Law Enforcement Training (BLET) activities can be fulfilled on-site
- Improved operational efficiency

Key Attributes

- **Secure storage** of impounded evidence and auction vehicles



Key Attributes

- **Modernization** of existing range



Key Attributes



- **Perimeter fencing** around the entire property
- The added fencing will serve as a safety precaution to deter individuals from inadvertently wondering onto the property

Key Attributes

- Increased **Officer Retention & Recruitment** by providing an attractive welcoming space for training



Key Attributes



- **Restroom Facilities –**
- Only a single porta john is currently available on-site with no running water
- The new facility will include both restrooms and locker rooms for staff and recruits

- Utilization of photovoltaics for power on roof of the new building
- Bullet capture systems for lead reclamation and recycling
- EV charging stations
- Pursuing LEED Silver certification
