Subject: Durham County Center Participation in a Southern SARE Professional Development Program Funded Project (Subaward Number: SUB00003731, Project # SPDP24-025 ELEY)

I serve as the Lead Investigator for the grant project entitled "Developing a Training Program on Surviving Disasters through Risk Management Preparation and Best Management Practices for Agricultural Producers." This project is funded by the Southern Region Sustainable Agriculture Research and Education Program – Professional Development Program (SARE-PDP).

The primary objective of this grant project is to provide professional development opportunities for Extension staff to enhance their capacity to conduct risk management programming with farmers, particularly within the context of natural and human-made hazards, as well as challenges stemming from climate change Through this initiative, we are equipping Extension and other agricultural professionals with the skills and resources needed to help small-scale producers identify, assess, and respond to risks; access relevant resources; and develop both personal and business risk management plans. The grant project is being piloted in four states—Texas, Tennessee, Arkansas, and North Carolina.

As part of this effort, Cooperative Extension at North Carolina A&T State University hosted a Disaster Risk Management Workshop (a joint Train-the-Trainer/ Instructional Session) for Extension educators in Cordova, Tennessee (outside of Memphis). Extension professionals from Texas, Tennessee, Arkansas and North Carolina attended this event. From North Carolina, we had two Extension agricultural agents, one Extension associate from NC State/CEFS, and a staff member from a farmer-driven nonprofit organization. John Lyttle (Small Farms & Local Foods Agent in Durham County) was one of the individuals from NC who attended. Following the training, Extension staff and partners were tasked with conducting localized risk management education programs with farmers in their respective counties or regions. Their focus will be on helping farmers establish risk management goals for their operations and identifying alternative strategies to address priority concerns.

Within the project budget, participating partners—including county Extension agents—are eligible for reimbursement of travel costs associated with attending the joint Train-the-Trainer event, as well as a participant stipend (@ \$1,500). The stipend is designed to offset costs associated with organizing local workshop events and providing individualized guidance to farmer participants. Invoices are permissible to recoup these costs. We have received a no-cost extension from the funding agency to continue this work through June 2026. If you have any further questions, please let me know.
