## **Agenda Action Form Overview**

Approval of the contract with BMS CAT in the amount of \$448,250.00 to perform duct cleaning and restoration at the County Detention Center, and the authority to execute change orders/amendments to the contract as long as funds are available in the CIP fund.

## **Background/Justification**

Duct systems require periodic cleaning and inspection to remove dust, molds, debris, and other allergens, that build up over time. This cleaning includes air handling units, VAV boxes, coils and other parts of the system. Duct cleaning improves air quality and system efficiency.

Duct systems that are not periodically cleaned, affect the HVAC system negatively. Dirty coils affect air flow to the spaces served, causing difficulty maintaining space temperatures. These air flow issues also cause pressures to increase within the duct system; this increase pressure causes sensors to decrease fan speeds. This again impacts the system negatively affecting air flow. Presently the system is experiencing some of these issues in the housing PODs.

Built up dust can lead to mold within the system; molds can cause respiratory issues for some individuals. Keeping duct system's clean mitigates these issues. Cleaning these systems also allows for the inspection of the insulation, possible duct leaks, and sealant issues, and can be addressed at this time and repaired, again increasing system efficiency.

## **Policy Impact**

This agenda is consistent with other repair and replacement projects overseen by the General Services Department. It is consistent with the policy of maintaining buildings for public and employee use.

#### **Procurement Background**

Approval of this contract aligns with the current Boards policy of maintaining County facilities in order to provide services to the community. It also aligns with the Counties' initiatives to provide those services in an environmentally sound manner.
