**Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement
Between the City of Durham and Durham County Creating a
Durham City-County Appearance Commission**

This Amendment (“Amendment”) is made and entered into on this the _____ day of _____, 2025 (“Effective Date”) between the following Parties: CITY OF DURHAM, a North Carolina municipal corporation (hereinafter “City”), and the COUNTY OF DURHAM, a political subdivision of the State of North Carolina (hereinafter “County”), and together collectively the COUNTY and the CITY may be referred to as the “Parties.”

BACKGROUND

- A. The City and County entered into an interlocal agreement for the creation of the Durham City-County Appearance Commission on April 24, 2023 (the “Agreement”).
- B. The Parties now wish to amend the agreement pursuant to section 8 of the Interlocal Agreement for the Creation of the Durham City-County Appearance Commission to shorten the duration of the agreement.
- C. As with the original Interlocal Agreement, this Amendment is made pursuant to the General Statutes of North Carolina at Chapter 160A, Article 20, Part 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein and the mutual benefits to result therefrom, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

Section 1. Section 7 “Titled Term of This Agreement” of the Agreement is deleted and replaced with the following:

This Agreement shall expire at 12:01 AM, January 1, 2026. The Parties may terminate this Agreement upon mutual written agreement of the Parties.

Section 2. Unless otherwise stated within this amendment all terms of the agreement remain in full force and effect.
