



**Agenda Action Form Overview**

The Board is requested to recognize Budget Ordinance Amendment No. 25BCC038 Public Health to Recognize \$230,000 from NC Department of Health and Human Services Division of Child and Family Well-Being for Evidence-Based Behavioral Health Interventions

**Background/Justification**

The Durham County Department of Public Health was awarded to increase the number of community-led social, emotional, and mental health programs that support the mental health and wellbeing of historically marginalized children, youth, and families in Durham. Funded community-led programs will include evidence-informed practices such as connecting young people to caring adults and activities, increasing caregivers’ social emotional support, and creating spaces for community interaction and support within Durham for marginalized communities.

The Board previously approved \$17,415 for AA 351 on June 10, 2024 during the FY 24-25 annual budget cycle. These funds (\$230,000) are to be added to that previously recognized award.

**Policy Impact**

Recognition of these funds are in line with current Board policy and do not require an exception.

**Procurement Background**

Contracted services will be obtained through a request for proposals and executed through the normal procurement process.

**Fiscal Impact**

Recognizing these revenues for the current fiscal year will allow for additional funding needed to carry out in the revised Addendum Agreement. No additional county funds are required.

**Recommendation**

The County Manager recommends that the Board approve this Budget Ordinance Amendment No. 25BCC038 Public Health to Recognize \$230,000 from NC Department of Health and Human Services Division of Child and Family Well-Being for Evidence-Based Behavioral Health Interventions
