The Board is requested to recognize Budget Ordinance Amendment No. 26BCC082 to Recognize \$3,590 from the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Child and Family Well-Being, Whole Child Health Section (WCHS)/School, Adolescent, and Child Health Unit (SACH) for the Maternal-Child Health Block Grant for Primary and Preventative Care

Background/Justification

The primary purpose of the Division of Child and Family Well-Being is to create and support programs and services that safeguard and improve the health and well-being of children and families.

The Durham County Department of Public Health received a one-time funding increase to support or ensure the delivery of preventive and primary healthcare services in accordance with North Carolina Administrative Code 10A NCAC 46.0204. This funding will support evidence-based or evidence-informed initiatives for children and youth that will: (1) decrease mortality and morbidity related to communicable diseases, injuries (both intentional and unintentional), and other preventable conditions; (2) promote healthy behaviors; and (3) enhance overall physical, social, and emotional health.

Policy Impact

Recognition of these funds is in line with current Board policy and does not require an exception.
