

**UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE  
TEXT AMENDMENT CONSISTENCY STATEMENT  
BY THE DURHAM BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REGARDING  
TC1700006, Technical Updates Regarding  
Sedimentation and Erosion Control and State Legislation**

**Whereas** the Durham Board of County Commissioners, upon acting on a text amendment to the *Unified Development Ordinance* and pursuant to NCGS § 153A-341, is required to approve a statement describing how the action is consistent with the *Durham Comprehensive Plan*; and

**Whereas** the Durham Board of County Commissioners, upon acting on a text amendment to the *Unified Development Ordinance* and pursuant to NCGS § 153A-341, is required to provide a brief statement indicating how the action is reasonable and in the public interest.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ADOPTED BY THE DURHAM BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS APPROPRIATE:**

**IN THE EVENT THAT THE MOTION TO APPROVE THE ORDINANCE IS ADOPTED,**

That final action regarding text amendment TC1700006, Technical Updates Regarding Sedimentation and Erosion Control and State Legislation, is based upon review of, and consistency with, the *Durham Comprehensive Plan* and any other officially adopted plan that is applicable, as provided in the “Issues” and “Consistency with the Comprehensive Plan; Reasonable and in the Public Interest” sections of the memo to the County Manager, dated February 26, 2018, regarding the subject “*Unified Development Ordinance* Text Amendment, Technical Updates Regarding Sedimentation and Erosion Control and State Legislation (TC1700006),” along with additional agenda information provided to the Board of County Commissioners and information provided at the public hearing; and

It is the objective of the Durham Board of County Commissioners to have the *Unified Development Ordinance* promote regulatory efficiency and consistency and the health, safety, and general welfare of the community. The text amendment promotes this by offering fair and reasonable regulations for the citizens and business community of the County of Durham as supported in the “Issues” and “Consistency with the Comprehensive Plan; Reasonable and in the Public Interest” sections of the memo to the County Manager, dated February 26, 2018, regarding the subject “*Unified Development Ordinance* Text Amendment, Technical Updates Regarding Sedimentation and Erosion Control and State Legislation (TC1700006),” along with additional agenda information provided to the City Council and information provided at the public hearing. Therefore, the amendment is reasonable and in the public interest.

It is the objective of the Durham Board of County Commissioners to have the *Unified Development Ordinance* promote regulatory efficiency and consistency and the health, safety, and general welfare of the community. The text amendment does not promote this and therefore is neither reasonable nor in the public interest.
