Summary: Project High Power is the construction and operation of a premium office headquarters for IONNA, a clean energy, technology, and electric vehicle charging company. IONNA will design, develop, build, and operate a unique, high-powered EV charging station network and customer experience that will lead to increased EV adoption in North America. The network will support and be open to electric vehicles of all brands. In addition to corporate functions, IONNA's new state-of-the-art facility in Durham will include a customer experience lab for research and development of the software and hardware to create a network of more than 30,000 EV charging points. The company was founded by a partnership of major automotive companies (BMW Group, General Motors, Honda, Hyundai, Kia, Mercedes-Benz, and Stellantis).
