

SCOPE OF SERVICES FORM

This Scope of Services is an integral part of this contract between the **Sheriff of Durham County**, a constitutional officer of the State of North Carolina, (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY") doing business as the **County of Durham**, and **Axon Enterprise, Inc.** a corporation duly authorized to do business in the state of North Carolina, (hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR"). which contract is dated November 1, 2025. Contractor agrees to provide services and/or materials pursuant to the provisions set forth below.

I. Background/Purpose: (Why - Provide a brief description of the services being procured.)

The Durham County Sheriff's Office provides a variety of less-lethal use of force options, such as the Advanced TASER Electronic Control Device, (ECD) manufactured by AXON. The current ECD have reached their end life cycle and require replacement. AXON has a product that fits the needs of the agency to replace the existing ECD. With this new contract, AXON will provide us with the equipment, training, and resources needed over the next 10 years to cover any Agency needs.

- III. Work/Requirements: (What/Where Be as detailed as possible in describing the work.). The Contractor shall provide the necessary labor, security, permits and safety measures as required to perform the following:

AXON will provide the number of ECDs and equipment specified in attachment 1A. Tasers and equipment will be issued by DCSO Taser Instructors to deputies/detention officers who have completed Taser Training. Training is provided in-house by certified Taser Instructors granted such permission through AXON. DCSO will ensure deputies and detention officers complete an annual refresher class each year taught by a Taser Instructor to maintain their certification.

Once the Tasers are procured from AXON, all deputies and detention officers that will be authorized to carry a Taser will have to complete the Taser 10 transition course taught by a Taser Instructor. After completion of this course, the deputy or detention officer will then be certified to carry the Taser 10. This transition to the new Taser 10 for the entire Agency will take about 4 months.

Upon date of procurement through purchase order, delivery of product will be within a reasonable time not to exceed 90 days. AXON product will be received and inventoried by DCSO.
