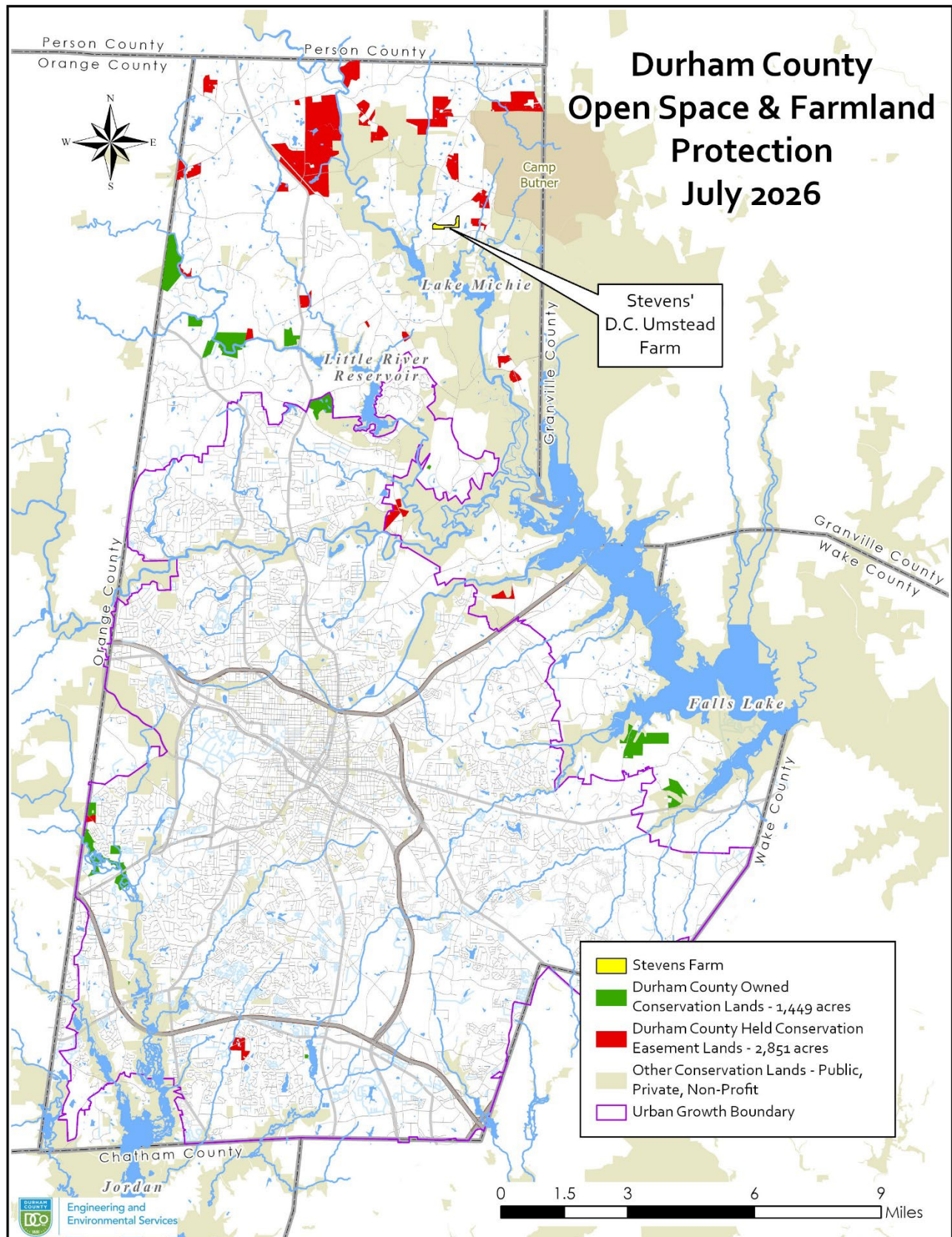
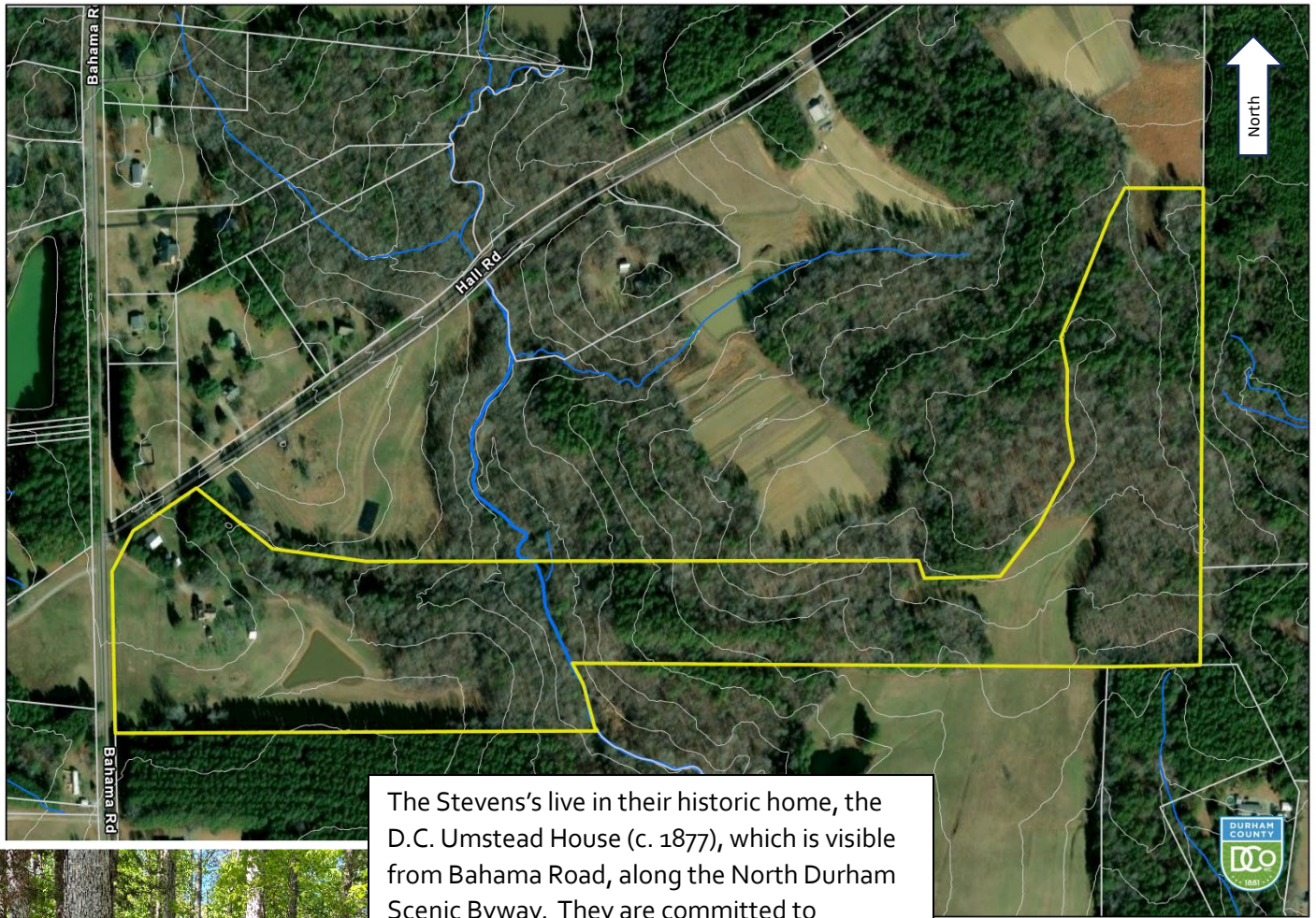

The Stevens's live in their historic home, the D.C. Umstead House (c. 1877), which is visible from Bahama Road, along the North Durham Scenic Byway. They are committed to permanently protect their land from development and to comprehensively manage the habitats for wildlife, water quality, and environmental benefits.

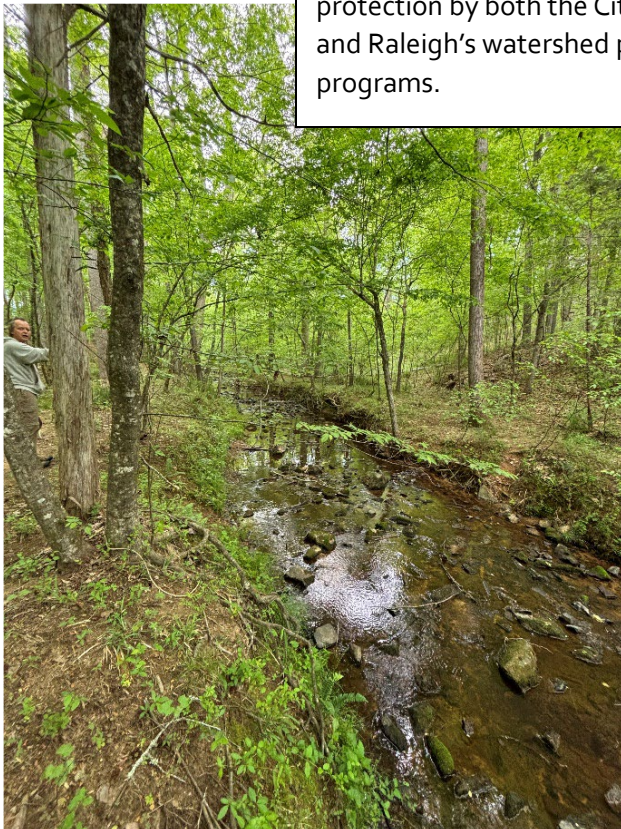

The D.C. Umstead Farm parcel is identified as significant for water quality protection by both the City of Durham's and Raleigh's watershed protection programs.



The D.C. Umstead Store building was also the Flat River Post Office as early as 1882. After they purchased the farm in 2012, the Stevens's worked closely with NC State Cultural Resources staff to register the farm and structures on the National Register of Historic Places.
