



### **Agenda Action Form Overview**

The Board is requested to approve funding for a contract with Ekos, Inc GE SOFTWARE INC for \$70,482.40 to upgrade fueling stations at General Services (Ramseur St), EMS1 (Memorial County Stadium), and Parkwood Fire Rescue #82 (Miami Blvd).

### **Background/Justification**

County fueling sites are in need of upgrades for proper consistent functioning. Current systems are hard to repair due to obsolescence, the difficulty in obtaining parts, and the poor reliability of currently existing electronic systems. This results in the system often crashing, requiring a lengthy manual reboot process. These issues negatively impact emergency responders, the Sheriff and EMS Departments, and County Fleet vehicles increasing refueling time and costs. Due to the frequency and length of the reboot time County users of the fuel stations often have resorted to local commercial fuel sources. This increases costs and administrative overhead.

EKOS offers Gasboy products and services that will upgrade County Stations to a more modern standard dramatically increasing system availability for County users. This will result in a drop in the use of commercial fuel sources which are sought as a short term immediate alternative to County Sites.

### **Procurement Background**

Current vendor in the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing system, Ekos, Inc operating under GE Software Inc, was solicited to provide an assessment regarding issues with County Fueling stations operation. A report was provided detailing pump equipment, electronic equipment, and software needed to correct existing issues with the County Fueling Stations. Based on this report the Fleet Supervisor and County Warehouse Manager have requested a quote obtained under the Gasboy and Veeder-Root Fuel and Fluid Dispensing and Management Systems Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Contract #092920-GVR to address the above issues.
