## RESOLUTION CERTIFYING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL BOND REFERENDUM ON THE BOND ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$13,995,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION MUSEUM BONDS HELD FOR THE COUNTY OF DURHAM, NORTH CAROLINA ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners (the "*Board*") of the County of Durham, North Carolina has considered the Certificate of Canvass of the Durham County Board of Elections canvassing the referendum held for the County of Durham, North Carolina on November 8, 2022 (the "*Referendum*") and certifying the result thereof to the Board and has canvassed the result of said Referendum.

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DURHAM, NORTH CAROLINA* that it be and hereby is certified and declared that the number of voters registered and qualified to vote at said Referendum was 239,432.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that it be and hereby is certified and declared that the total number of voters who voted **"Yes"** in answer to the question

"SHALL the order authorizing \$13,995,000 of bonds to pay the capital costs of expanding and improving the facilities for the North Carolina Museum of Life and Science, including making improvements to exhibits, expanding meeting space, supporting upgrades to HVAC systems and undertaking projects to improve sustainability, and providing that additional taxes may be levied in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds be approved?"; was <u>98,448</u>. The total number of voters who voted "No" in answer to such question was <u>26,273</u>. The question in the form submitted was **APPROVED** by the affirmative vote of a majority of those who voted thereon at said Referendum.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that a statement declaring the result of said Referendum shall be prepared, delivered to the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners for filing and recordation, and published in accordance with law.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its adoption.
