Congratulations! We are pleased to inform you that of the 64 applications submitted, your application was one of 7 proposals awarded a 2018 CATCH Planning (cycle 1) grant.

The mission of CATCH is to support pediatricians to collaborate within their communities so that all children have access to needed health services and a medical home. This is a major goal of the Academy, and we are pleased that you have undertaken a commitment to help realize the vision of CATCH through your project.

Pending any final budget revisions, you have been approved to receive up to \$10,000 to carry out your project.
