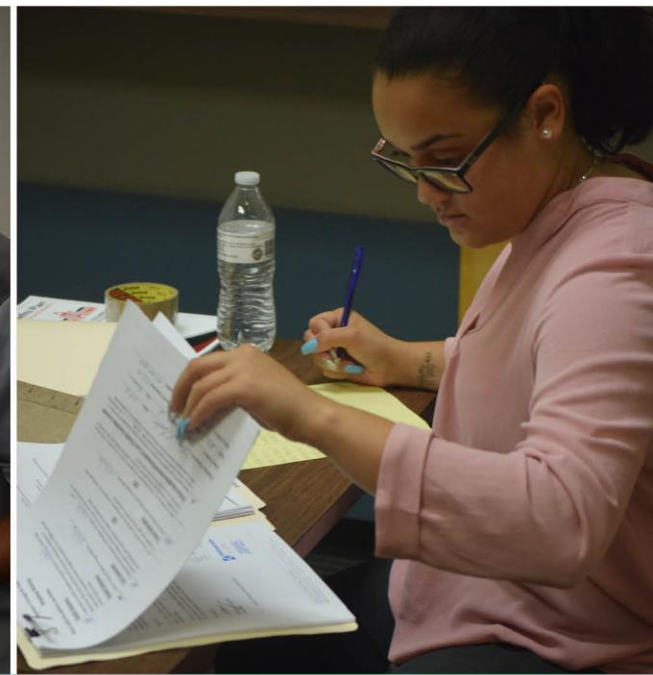
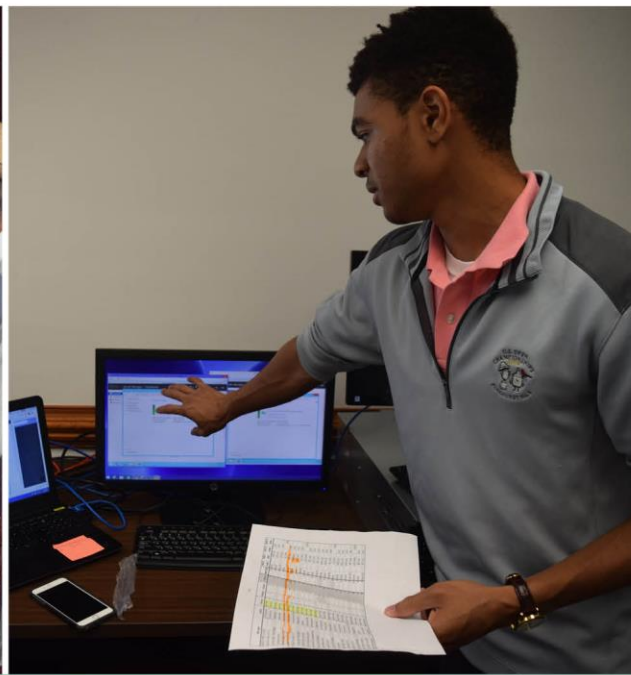

Middle College Action Project

- Vision
