## EXTRACTS FROM MINUTES OF BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Durham, North Carolina, was duly held on January 14, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. in the Commissioners' Chambers on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor of the Durham County Government Administrative Complex at 200 East Main Street in Durham, North Carolina. The following bond order was introduced by reading the title thereof:

## BOND ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$50,000,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION REFUNDING BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF DURHAM, NORTH CAROLINA

*WHEREAS*, the County of Durham, North Carolina (the "*County*") has issued a General Obligation Public Improvement Bond Anticipation Note, Series 2017 in the principal amount of \$50,000,000 (the "2017 Bond Anticipation Note");

*WHEREAS*, the Board of Commissioners of the County (the "*Board of Commissioners*") deems it advisable to refund the 2017 Bond Anticipation Note;

*WHEREAS*, an application has been filed with the Secretary of the Local Government Commission of North Carolina (the "*Commission*") requesting approval of the bonds hereinafter described as required by the Local Government Bond Act, as amended, and the Secretary of the Commission has notified the Board of Commissioners that the application has been accepted for submission to the Commission.

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED* by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Durham, North Carolina, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners deems it advisable to refund the 2017 Bond Anticipation Note.

Section 2. To raise the money required to pay the costs of refunding the 2017 Bond Anticipation Note, General Obligation Refunding Bonds of the County are hereby authorized and shall be issued pursuant to the Local Government Bond Act of North Carolina. The maximum aggregate principal amount of such General Obligation Refunding Bonds authorized by this bond order shall be and not exceed \$50,000,000.

Section 3. Taxes will be levied in an amount sufficient to pay the principal and interest of the General Obligation Refunding Bonds.

Section 4. A sworn statement of the County's debt has been filed with the Interim Clerk to the Board and is open to public inspection.

Section 5. This bond order is effective on its adoption.

After the introduction of the bond order, Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_\_ introduced the

following resolution, a copy of which had been provided to each Commissioner:

*WHEREAS*, the bond order entitled:

## **"BOND ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$50,000,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION REFUNDING BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF DURHAM, NORTH CAROLINA"**

has been introduced at a meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Durham, North Carolina this 14th day of January, 2019;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 159-68 of the North Carolina General Statutes, as amended, the

County must hold a public hearing on this bond order;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to provide for the holding of a public hearing

thereon on January 28, 2019 and the submission of a statement of debt in connection therewith as required

by the Local Government Bond Act.

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED* by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Durham, North Carolina as follows:

The public hearing upon said bond order shall be held on the 28th day of January, 2019 at
7:00 p.m. in the Commissioners' Chambers on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor of the Durham County Government
Administrative Complex at 200 East Main Street in Durham, North Carolina.

2. The Interim Clerk to the Board is hereby directed to cause a copy of the bond order to be published with a notice of such hearing in the form prescribed by law in a qualified newspaper no fewer than six days before such public hearing.

3. The County's Chief Financial Officer is hereby directed to file with the Interim Clerk to the Board before publication of the bond order with the notice of such public hearing, a statement setting forth the debt incurred or to be incurred, the appraised value of property subject to taxation by the County and the net debt of the County.
