Duties will include developing and offering a health information outreach program for Durham County Library. Sample projects may include:

- Developing health information programs;
- Developing and hosting health programs at Durham County Library locations;
- Integrating NNLM resources and tools into health information programming, coordinating and hosting health expert speaker series;
- Distributing and placing health information materials within public library user spaces;
- Developing health education storytime programs for children; and
- Offering a health information courses to staff in service courses on effectively searching and identifying health information resources.

The programming scope will include general health information topics and educational programs to increase awareness of personal connected health, personalized medicine and the NIH *All of Us* initiative.

The program coordinator will report to and be supervised by the appropriate Durham County Library Administrator with direction provided by the NNLM SCR *All of Us* Community Engagement Coordinator.

<u>ALA 2019 and PLA 2020 Conferences</u> - Travel is budgeted for the program coordinator and project managers to travel to the American Library Association (ALA) 2019 Annual Conference June 20 – 25, 2019 in Washington, DC. Travel cost includes registration to ALA, flights, and hotel for three people for ALA in June 2019, which equals about \$5,000. Project Manager Stephanie Fennell will travel to Nashville, TN for the PLA 2020 Conference, February 25 – 29, 2020. Travel to PLA in 2020 for one person is about \$1,200. Both these conferences cover various topics deeply relevant to the work of public libraries and to ensuring staff have the expertise to implement successful projects, such as *All of Us*. These in-person trainings are crucial for imbedded program staff and project managers to maintain motivation and connection to their rapidly evolving work.
