## ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD

## **Current Vacancy Announcement:**

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (ABC) is appointed by the County Commissioners as policy makers for ABC stores and ABC Law Enforcement. The ABC Board controls the operation and management of the ABC stores and performs any other activities authorized or required by ABC Law.

## **Proposed Vacancy Announcement:**

Established by State Statute. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board has control and jurisdiction over the sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages; has power and authority to adopt rules and regulations governing the operation of stores; to locate, furnish and equip stores and provide management of the same; direct the duties and services of all employees; requires the sale of alcoholic beverages at the prices fixed by the State Board of Alcoholic Beverage Control. Appointments are made for three-year terms with no one serving more than three consecutive full terms. The Chairman of the ABC Board is designated by the County Commission.

**Qualifications**: N.C. General Statute 18B-700 (d) Qualifications states the appointing authority shall appoint members of a local board on the basis of the appointees' interest in public affairs, good judgment, knowledge, ability, and good moral character.

In addition to N.C. General Statute 18B-700 (d) the Board of County Commissioners will use the following qualifications in the screening process for appointment consideration to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board:

- High personal and professional ethics, integrity, practical wisdom and mature judgment;
- Broad training and experience in policy-making decisions in business, government, education, technology, substance abuse education or prevention training;
- Expertise, including, but not limited to, financial literacy, retailing experience at the management level, and board governance, performance and dynamics, that is useful to the ABC Board and complementary to the background and experience of other directors;
- Willingness to devote the amount of time necessary to prepare thoroughly for all Board meetings in advance, to carry out the duties and responsibilities of Board membership; knowledge of the ABC Laws, rules of the State ABC Commission and the Durham's County Board's ethics and other policies applicable to Board members;
- Willingness to objectively appraise management performance.
