We are pleased to inform you that the County of Durham CFAT application for the purchase, installation and deployment of eight (8) level 2 electric vehicle chargers has been approved. The grant award is for \$26,149.00; matching funding required by County of Durham is \$40,899.00.

You will shortly receive a statement of work (SOW), based on your application and modifications that occurred during the application and review process, for review and approval. After approval, it will be submitted to the NCSU Contracts and Grants office to generate a formal contract. This is the time to be sure of project parameters and timing. This award is for reimbursement of a fixed amount. If the costs to complete the project exceed the approved amount, the additional costs will be borne by the County of Durham. However, if the project costs are less than the estimated budget, the amount reimbursed may not be the full amount. The amount reimbursed will be subject to the 20% minimum cost share requirement.

After the SOW is finalized, we encourage you to issue a press release and take advantage of every opportunity to educate others about your use of alternative fuel(s) and advanced transportation technologies. Along with recognizing the NC Clean Energy Technology Center, please acknowledge the NC Department of Environmental Quality.
