^{*} Notes from Dr. Erickson:

This year we have demonstrated amazing progress in our system for keeping inventory and tracking our book flow. We have successfully implemented a tracking system using a group Excel sheet where books are inventoried on arrival and then tracked after they leave our inventory room. The number of books leaving our inventory room has been used as a proxy for book distribution and has provided us with an improved ability to track book provision when compared to past strategies. This process, however, slightly overestimates our book distribution because it includes books that have left our inventory room but have not yet been distributed to patients. In the last two years we created a novel system to use our electronic medical record to track book provision, which will more accurately represent book distribution by relying on provider documentation. At the Roxboro clinic site, 96% of providers are using this system with a book provision rate of 91%. We plan to increase provider compliance with this documentation system at our other two sites over the next three months.
