**WHEREAS,** Sidney Brodie has devoted his life to illuminating the destructive

outcome of fear and despair; to helping Durham's citizens pay attention to the problem and begin conversations to end the

violence; and

WHEREAS, Sidney Brodie's tremendous personal sacrifices and continuing

dedication to making Durham a safer community for all its residents exemplifies how one individual can make a difference;
