The Board is requested to approve this Budget Ordinance Amendment No. BCC000050 Public Health to recognize \$6,500.00 from NC DHHS Division of Public Health CDI/ Cancer Prevention and Control Branch

Background/Justification

In the United States, breast cancer is the second most commonly diagnosed cancer in women. Cervical cancer, once the leading cause of death for women in the U.S., has significantly decreased in incidence and mortality since the Pap test was introduced in 1948. The NC Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program (BCCCP) is a screening program. The goal of the NC BCCCP is to reduce the morbidity and mortality due to breast and cervical cancers in women by providing breast and cervical cancer screening services for eligible underserved women in North Carolina.
