SECTION 1 – EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Re: Snow Hill Road Pump Station Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP-1) – Early Sitework Package

Dear Mr. Chirichella:

Wharton-Smith is pleased to submit the draft version of the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP-1) – Early Sitework Package for your review. Based on the 30% Design Set and Addenda 1-3, the total Guaranteed Maximum Price for Phase 1 of the Snow Hill Pump Station is **\$2,850,335**. For bidding the work, Wharton-Smith utilized the 30% Design Set produced by Hazen, Inc. on January 31, 2020. Construction includes erosion control, site clearing, rock blasting, pump station excavation and backfill, site rough grading, and existing sanitary sewer relocation. Following this letter is a comprehensive breakdown of GMP-1 including the cost breakdown, bid tabulation, schedule, subcontractor and suppliers' bids.

Please note the following clarifications regarding this proposal:

- 1. Wharton-Smith issued the 30% Bid Set and Addendum 1-3. Bids were submitted to Wharton-Smith on April 9th, 2020 and a re-advertisement bid took place on April 27th, 2020.
- 2. Wharton-Smith has evaluated the bids for the determination if they are responsive and responsible bidders. Wharton-Smith recommends the following subcontractors for award for the various bid packages:
 - a. Erosion Control Sullivan Eastern, Inc.
 - b. Site Clearing Sullivan Eastern, Inc.
 - c. Rock Blasting Sullivan Eastern, Inc.
 - d. Pump Station Excavation & Backfill Sullivan Eastern, Inc.
- 3. Additional Direct Cost incurred to obtain the most competitive subcontractor pricing:
 - a. Excavation Design to Reduce Risk included in Subcontractor Bid Packages: \$25,000
 - b. Site Maintenance, MOT, Layout, Security, Erosion Control, Road Maintenance: \$97,968
- 4. The following allowances were set up for the items related to the project that require additional details in order to provide Durham County with the most competitive pricing:
 - a. Erosion Control Quantity Allowance \$5,670
 - b. Site Clearing Quantity Allowance \$9,600
 - c. Rock Blasting Quantity Allowance \$63,300
 - d. Pump Station Excavation & Backfill Quantity Allowance \$59,584
 - e. Material Testing Allowance \$30,000
- 5. An 8% Owner's Contingency has been carried in order to be utilized for unforeseen conditions.



- 6. A 4% Design Builder Contingency has been carried for uninsurable risk as Design Builder.
- 7. The project schedule has been included with <u>180</u> days allotted to GMP-1 Scope.
