EES Stormwater & Erosion Control Division – Recommended Budget

- 2 New FTE's
 - Erosion Control Supervisor
 - GIS Analyst
 - ½ Year Funding
- Delay implementation of new Stormwater Utility Enterprise Fund, while initiating work necessary to meet unfunded mandates
- Jordan and Falls Lake Rules Compliance Program Development

EES Stormwater & Erosion Control Division – Recommended Budget

- S&EC Division Trends
 - Record-High Permit Load –
 Currently 184 Active
 Permits with +/- 40
 Pending
 - Division Manager and Stormwater Manager are spending approximately 70% of time on Erosion Control; need to refocus to meet regulations
 - Falls and Jordan Lake Rules are coming

EES Stormwater & Erosion Control Division – Recommended Budget

- Falls and Jordan Rules Recap
 - Nutrient Reduction Measures Required
 - Total cost estimate = Approximately \$75 million by 2041 → Unfunded Mandate
 - NCDEQ Schedule → Falls Rules Stage I will begin by July 2021
- Rules compliance measures will require a shift in focus of S&EC Division
 - New staffing is essential to make the shift
