Alcoholic Beverage Control Board: This board has control and jurisdiction over the sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages; has power and authority to adopt rules and regulations governing the operation of stores; to locate, furnish and equip stores and provide management of the same; direct the duties and services of all employees; requires the sale of alcoholic beverages at the prices fixed by the State Board of Alcoholic Beverage Control.

Board of Adjustment: This board holds quasi-judicial public hearings to determine requests made by property owners in the City and County of Durham for minor and custodial care special use permits, variances and appeals of administrative interpretations or decision, as authorized by State law and local ordinance. The BOA is composed of ten members—seven members and three alternates—appointed by the Durham City Council and the Board of Commissioners. The Board of County Commissioners appoints three members and two alternates of whom at least three must reside outside the city limits.
