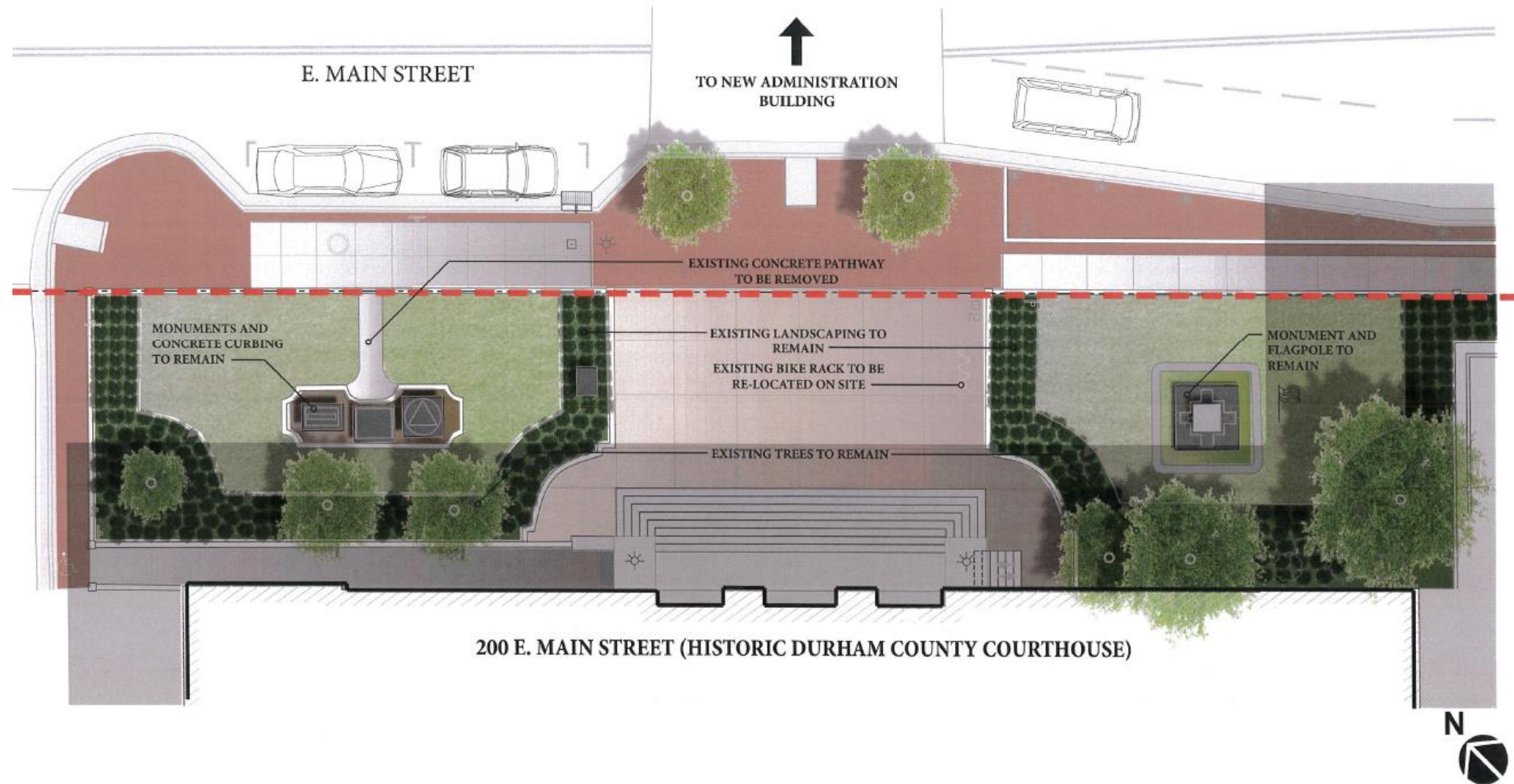




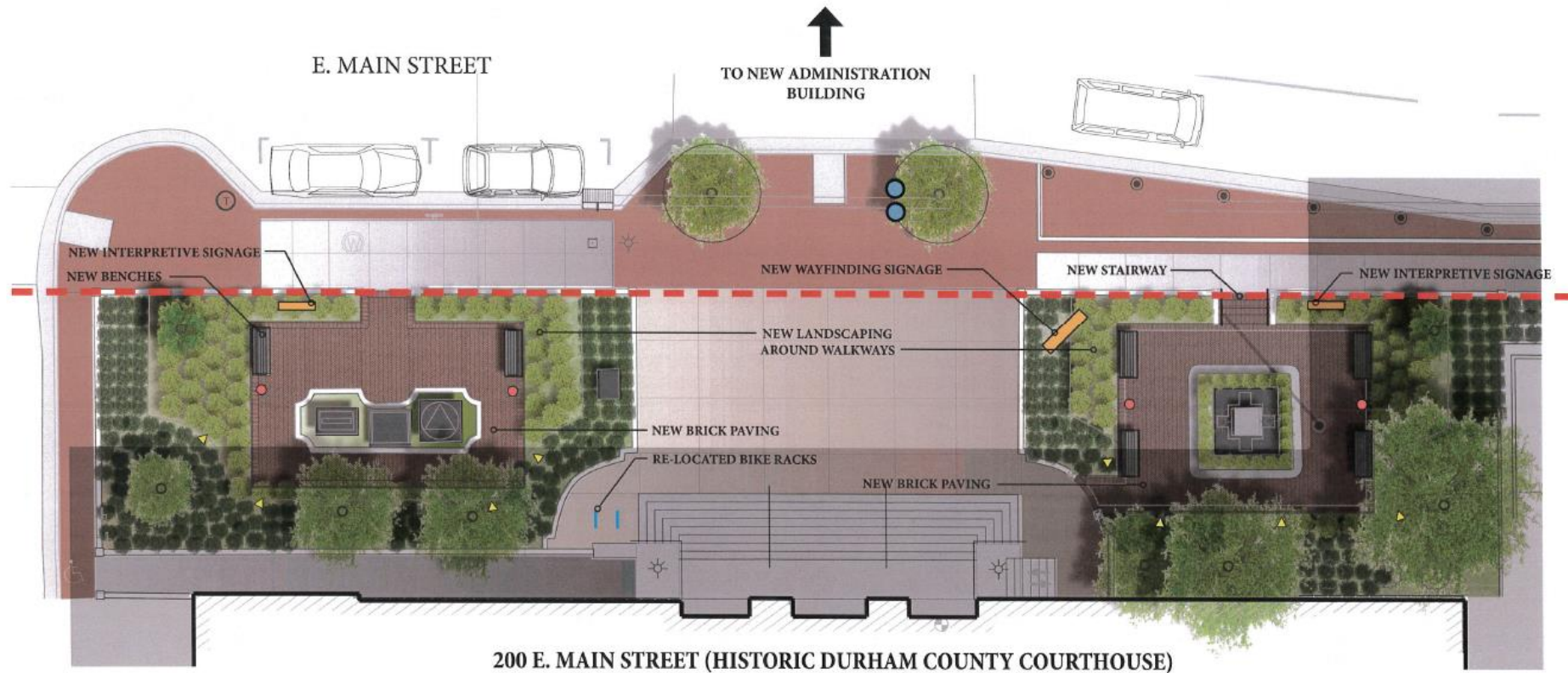

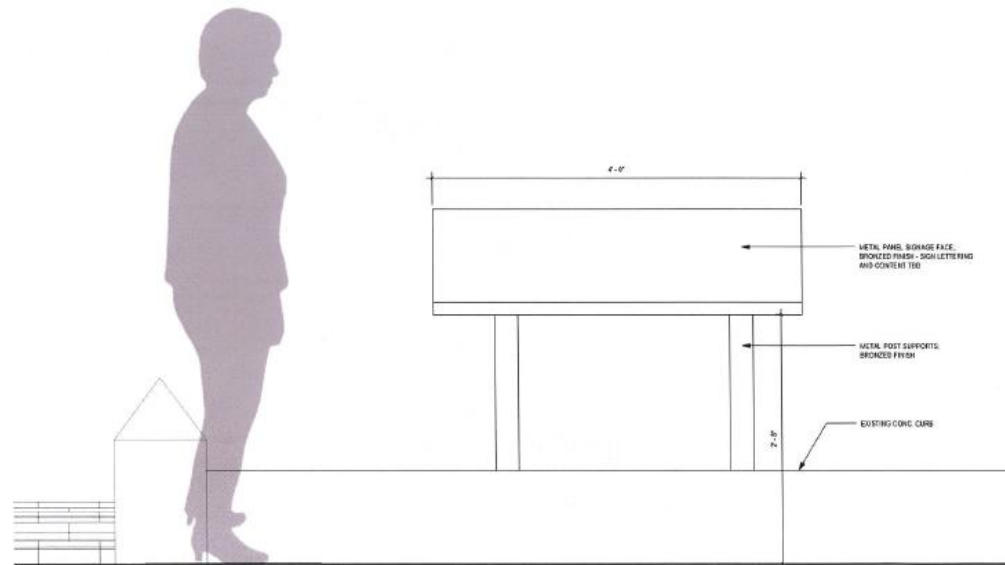

Honoring Their Courage

**To commemorate and recognize all Durham County soldiers
that fought so bravely in
World War I-1917-1919. Durham County honors all the men
for their acts of service. When the call came to defend this
Nation; all races, creeds and colors stood tall to fight for and
defend our freedom.**

The original commission of this monument in 1921 recognized the bravery of these soldiers, but separated the honored by race. We want to recognize that courage, patriotism and love of country has no race, by combining the list of names of the brave men that served and lost their lives in WWI.

Resolution from the Durham City/County Appearance Commission adopted May 15, 2013. Submitted to BOCC June 3, 2013, by Mr. Eddie Davis.
