

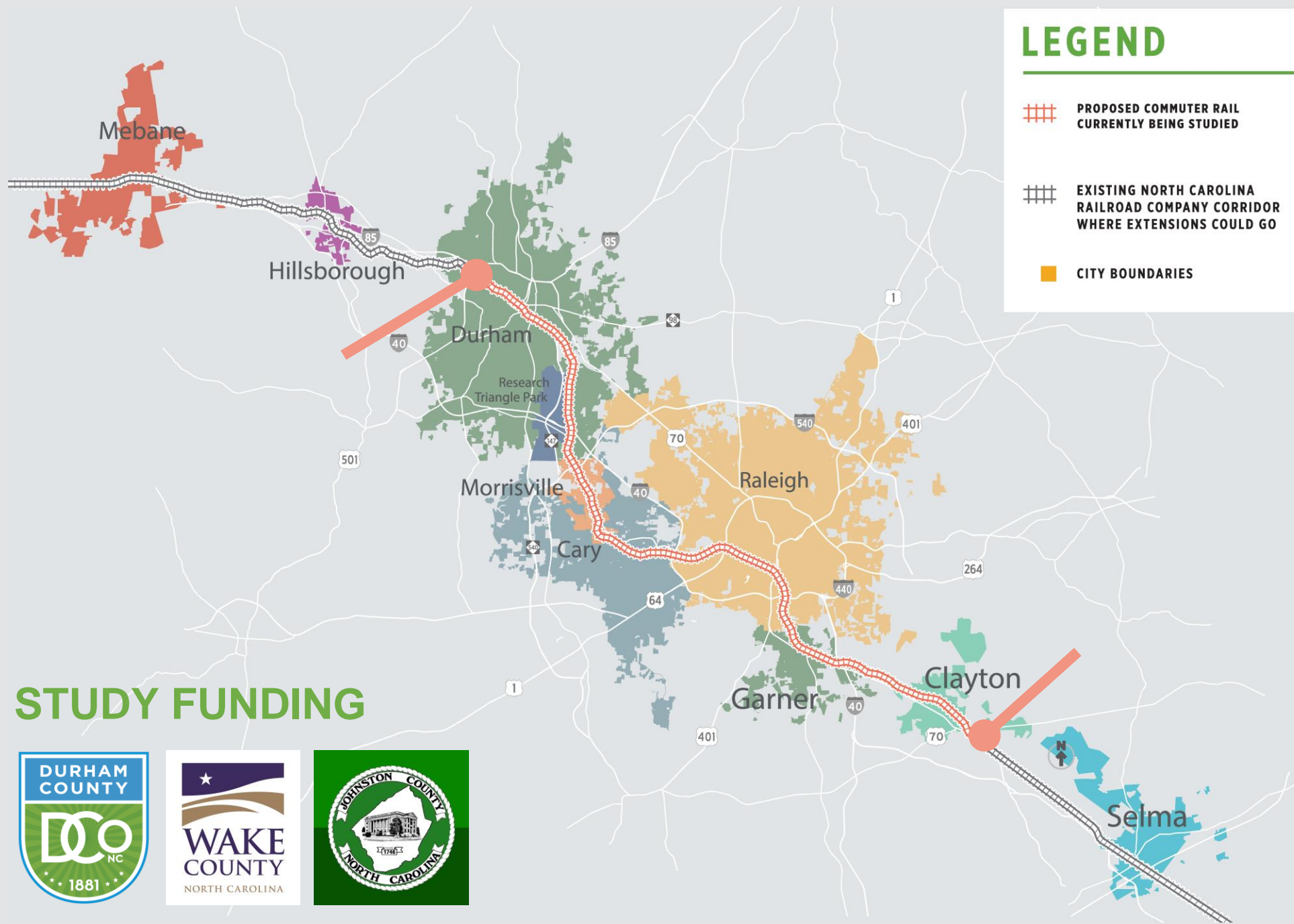

## LEGEND

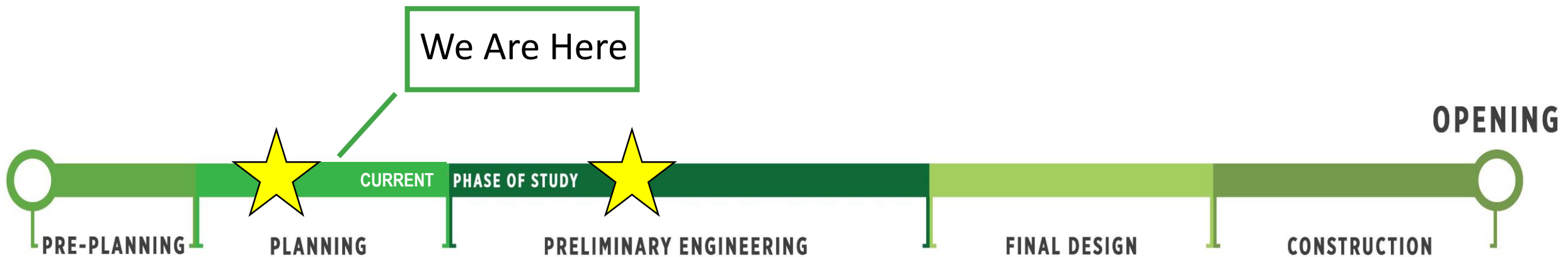
-  PROPOSED COMMUTER RAIL

# CURRENT STUDY
