Coronavirus Relief Funding from State		
<p>The Board of County Commissioners is requested to approve recognizing \$5,480,715 of Corona Relief Funds received from the State of North Carolina to support a portion of County COVID related costs. These funds will support already incurred costs by the County and will lower the General Fund fund balance burden in support of these COVID-19 costs. These grant funds will support COVID-19 expenditures in the current fiscal year and FY 2020-21. The balance of grant dollars that are not committed (e.g., encumbered) at fiscal year-end will carry over into FY 2020-21 as restricted fund balance.</p> <p>Eligible expenses under the CRF Plan (the “Plan”) include: medical expenses, public health expenses, payroll expenses, expenses of actions to facilitate compliance with COVID-19 related public health measures, expenses associated with the provision of economic support in connection with the COVID-19 public health emergency, and any other COVID-19 related expenses reasonably necessary to the function of government. The funds will offset County expenses after the standard compliance occurs. All funds must be expended by December 31, 2020 and will be subject to a performance and fiscal review by the State Auditor.</p> <p>The Board on County Commissioners approved the County’s CRF plan on June 8, 2020 and the plan was submitted to NC PRO on June 9. A copy of the approved plan is provided as backup.
