## **Request for Board Action:**

The Board is requested to proclaim and honor August 11-17, 2019 as Algonquin Week in Durham County.

The Algonquin Tennis Club reached out to the broad black community during the era of segregation and helped to develop the tennis skills of many Durham youth.

Durham County's 24<sup>th</sup> State Historical Marker will be erected and unveiled on Thursday, August 15<sup>th</sup> at the W.D Hill Recreation Center on Fayetteville St.
