Request for Board Action:

The Board is requested to conduct a public hearing and consider the following motions:

- 1) Adopt a Consistency Statement as required by NCGS 153A-341; and
- 2) Adopt an ordinance amending the Unified Development Ordinance by taking property out of the Industrial Light with a Development Plan (IL(D)) zoning district and establishing the same as Industrial Light (IL) zoning district.

Summary: This is a request to change the zoning atlas for property located at 10500 World Trade Boulevard from Industrial Light with a Development Plan (IL(D)) to Industrial Light (IL). Staff determines that this request is consistent with the *Comprehensive Plan* and applicable policies and ordinances.
