## **Design Services Amendment for the Triangle Wastewater Treatment Plant Efficiency and Resiliency Improvements Project (RFQ 17-012)**

## **Request For Board Action:**

The Board is requested to authorize the County Manager to enter into a contract amendment to increase the existing design consultant contract with Black & Veatch International Company (FR# 17-832) for the Efficiency and Resiliency Improvements Project (RFQ 17-012) in the amount of \$126,000, bringing the total contract amount from \$275,500 to \$401,500, and to execute any other related contracts, including amendments, not to exceed \$450,000.
