Durham Master Aging Plan Proposal

Date of BOCC Meeting: December 20, 2018

Request for Board Action:

The Board is requested to receive and approve a Master Aging Plan (MAP) proposal for Durham from Triangle J Council of Governments (TJCOG).

In May 2018, the Board of County Commissioners and the City Council received the results of the Durham Livability Self-Assessment using TJCOG Livability Self-Assessment Tool for Local Governments. The findings will be a foundation for the MAP. Mitchell Heflin, MD and Eleanor McConnell, PhD Co-Directors, Duke Geriatric Workforce Enhancement Program (GWEP) committed to contributing \$7,500 for specific components of the project. The total cost of the project is \$35,710 which includes a contingency amount of \$1,701. Durham County's contribution will not exceed \$28,210. The Board included funding for this project in the FY 18-19 adopted budget.
